

Elegant Cabled Scarf



The Elegant Cabled Scarf is made up of a simple elongated double-cable pattern, repeated three times across the width of the scarf. A garter stitch edging keeps the sides looking neat and provides stability.

Finished size: 6 inches x 62 inches

Yarn: Knitpicks Wool of the Andes (100% Peruvian Wool; 110 yds/ 50 gr); Hollyberry, 4 balls. If you're sensitive to wool, you may want to choose another yarn as this one is a bit scratchy around the neck.

Needles: US 8 and one cable needle

Gauge: 4.5 sts/ 1 inch on US 7-8

Special stitches: C6B: slip next 3 stitches onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, K3, then K3 from the cable needle.

CO 42 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K2, P2, K2, P6, K2, P2, K2, P6, K2, P2, K2, P6, K2, P2, K2

Row 2 (RS): K4, P2, K6, P2, K2, P2, K6, P2, K2, P2, K6, P2, K4

Rows 3 - 11: K2, knit sts as they appear to last 2 sts, K2

Row 12: K4, P2, C6B, P2, K2, P2, C6B, P2, K2, P2, C6B, P2, K4

Rows 13 - 15: K2, knits sts as they appear to last 2 sts, K2

Row 16: Repeat Row 12

Repeat these 16 rows 21 times or until desired length.

Repeat rows 1-11. BO in pattern. Weave in ends. Block lightly.

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
